


PROVISIONS FOR ENCROACHMENT For Petition 1829

Detroit Water and Sewerage (DWSD) agree to the proposed encroachment subject to the fulfilling of the following provisions:

- 1. By approval of this petition the (DWSD) does not waive any of its rights to its facilities located in the right of way, and at all time, DWSD, its agents or employees, shall have the right to enter upon the right of way to maintain, repair, alter, service, inspect, or install its facilities. All costs incident to the damaging, dismantling, demolishing, removal and replacement of structures or other improvements herein permitted and incurred in gaining access to DWSD's facilities for maintenance, repairing, alteration, servicing or inspection caused by the encroachment shall be borne by the petitioner. All costs associated with gaining access to DWSD's facilities, which could normally be expected had the petitioner not encroached into the right of way shall be borne by DWSD.
- 2. All construction performed under this petition shall not be commenced until after five (5) days written notice to DWSD. Seventy-two (72) hours notice shall also be provided in accordance with P.A. 53 1974, as amended, utilizing the MISS DIG one call system.
- 3. Construction under this petition is subject to inspection and approval by DWSD forces. The cost of such inspection shall, at the discretion of DWSD, be borne by the petitioner.
- 4. If DWSD facilities located within the right of way shall break or be damaged as the result of any action on the part of the petitioner, then in such event the petitioner agrees to be liable for all costs incident to the repair, replacement or relocation of such broken or damaged DWSD facilities.
- The petitioner shall hold DWSD harmless for any damage to the encroaching device constructed or installed under this petition, which may be caused by the failure of DWSD's facilities.
- 6. It is DWSD's requirement that any proposed utility crossing DWSD water mains or sewers perpendicularly must maintain a minimum of 18 inches vertical clearance. Also any proposed utility running adjacent to DWSD water mains and sewers must maintain a minimum of 10 feet lateral clearance including any conduit and/or manholes walls. No utility is allowed to run along the top of the water main or sewer.
- 7. There are possibilities of several water and sewer service lines crossing in the vicinity of proposed work, field verify their location and depth to maintain our required clearance.
- 8. For any proposed work that involves DWSD utilities (water mains and/or sewers), an approval and a permit is required from DWSD before the commencement of work.

RE: Giffels Webster, 28 W. Adams, Suite 1200, Detroit, MI 48226 on behalf of Olympia Development of Michigan, LLC and its affiliate Fox Theatre, 2211 Woodward Avenue, Detroit, MI 48201, request to encroach public rights-of-way with a private storm water management system on Montcalm Street

The Fox Theater is having its storm sewer outlet upgraded to redirect a portion of the stormwater to Montcalm Street and ultimately into the existing sewer in Park Avenue. Giffels Webster respectfully requests sub-surface encroachments for a private storm sewer in the following public right-of-ways:

- Montcalm Street, between Park Avenue and Woodward Avenue, an encroachment area of 225'x16';
 beginning at east ROW of Park Avenue and extending 225 feet east, and 16 feet northerly from south Montcalm ROW
- Park Avenue at Montcalm Street, an encroachment area of 31'x27'; beginning at east ROW of Park Avenue and extending 31 feet west, and 11 feet southerly from south Montcalm ROW and 16 feet northerly from south Montcalm ROW

All work outlined above will be performed per Michigan Plumbing Code, City of Detroit, CED, and DWSD Standards. Limits of the requested encroachments can be found in the attachment, enclosed herein.
