submits this Petition to request a Conversion to Easement of the westerly 8 feet of the norths public alley immediately adjacent to the above property along its east boundary.

We respectfully request action on this Petition as soon as may be possible.

We submit this Petition for security purposes to protect the east side of our building. This area gets significant foot traffic passing very close to the building, and as a result, there have been multiple incidents of broken windows on that side. If our Petition is granted, we plan to extend a chairblink fence (that currently runs along the back of the property) down the center of the alley toward the front of the property to prevent passers-by from walking right up to the building.

Attached to this letter are the following documents:

- 1) A copy of the Deed as proof of ownership of the above property;
- 2) An aerial photograph of the building, adjacent alley, and surrounding area.

### Mr. Williams,

Thank you for contacting me about the Petition of Detroit Community Outreach to have the side alley closed that is adjacent to our property located at 3726 Glynn Court, Detroit.

I understand from our conversation that, going forward, the Petition will be amended to request a closure of the whole alley (that is, the entire width of the alley rather than just half the width) from Glynn Court to the back line of our property, which coincides with the south edge of the rear alley. If said closure is possible, that would be exactly what our organization desires. And this is for the purpose of increased security. We do not wish or intend to build any structure on the alley; we only wish to erect a security fence on that side of our property.


