

#### PROVISIONS FOR ENCROACHMENT For Petition 1833

Detroit Water and Sewerage (DWSD) agree to the proposed encroachment subject to the fulfilling of the following provisions:

- 1. By approval of this petition the (DWSD) does not waive any of its rights to its facilities located in the right of way, and at all time, DWSD, its agents or employees, shall have the right to enter upon the right of way to maintain, repair, alter, service, inspect, or install its facilities. All costs incident to the damaging, dismantling, demolishing, removal and replacement of structures or other improvements herein permitted and incurred in gaining access to DWSD's facilities for maintenance, repairing, alteration, servicing or inspection caused by the encroachment shall be borne by the petitioner. All costs associated with gaining access to DWSD's facilities, which could normally be expected had the petitioner not encroached into the right of way shall be borne by DWSD.
- 2. All construction performed under this petition shall not be commenced until after five (5) days written notice to DWSD. Seventy-two (72) hours notice shall also be provided in accordance with P.A. 53 1974, as amended, utilizing the MISS DIG one call system.
- 3. Construction under this petition is subject to inspection and approval by DWSD forces. The cost of such inspection shall, at the discretion of DWSD, be borne by the petitioner.
- 4. If DWSD facilities located within the right of way shall break or be damaged as the result of any action on the part of the petitioner, then in such event the petitioner agrees to be liable for all costs incident to the repair, replacement or relocation of such broken or damaged DWSD facilities.
- The petitioner shall hold DWSD harmless for any damage to the encroaching device constructed or installed under this petition, which may be caused by the failure of DWSD's facilities.

Application for Encroachment into Right of Way City of Detroit

The SheWolf restaurant will soon be under construction, as a tenant build-out in an existing newly constructed building in the New Center area. A main portion of the restaurant will occupy a recently approved addition onto the front of the new building which abuts the front property line. There is a seasonal outdoor café seating for 30 proposed on the sidewalk, similar to other outdoor cafes in the city.

In conjunction with the cafe, we are proposing three integral components in the Selden Street Right of Way: a retractable awning with a support structure, a planting bed with a hedge, and a sculpture.

#### Awning framework:

In order to shield the patio seating from sun & rain we are proposing a retractable canvas awning along Selden Street. In order to support the awning framework when open a painted steel tube framework is being proposed. This acts as not only a structural support but a decorative framework in front of the building when the awning is closed. Minimal foundations (with tops at 12" below grade) are proposed at the post bases to prevent the frame from heaving, but could be covered with concrete paving if needed in the future. Stainless steel cables are proposed between the posts, so that flowering vine tendrils can climb up in the warmer months as a soft accent detail. This framework would remain throughout the year, but is located within the proposed planting bed so as not to be an obstacle on the sidewalk.

#### Planting bed:

The planting bed is proposed as an opening in the concrete sidewalk, with a viburnum hedge. The hedge acts as a screening element for the patrons seated in the café, but also brings much needed landscaping up closer to the street. This hedge falls in line with similar landscaping areas along Selden (specifically the neighboring church building), and would allow for the same 6' clear path for walking along the sidewalk.

#### Sculpture:

As a civic component to the project, a custom made sculpture is proposed in a prominent location along Selden Street. This sculpture would sit on a hollow steel plate base, anchored to the sidewalk with

tamper-proof bolts. The statue base would have sign letters for the restaurant, and integral lighting for the sculpture. Though this would remain year round, the installation would be easily removable if needed in the future, no differently than the typical removable metal railings in the city. Power to this sign and to the landscape lights within the planting bed would be supplied from the building, and run in a conduit under the sidewalk. This power supply could also be easily terminated at the building if needed in the future.


All of these components have intentionally been brought up as close as possible to Selden Street itself, in order to enliven the street, create a pedestrian scale and engage pedestrian traffic. Selden Street has an large right of way, and the current 18' deep sidewalk more than accommodates these improvements.

Please feel free to contact me if any additional information is needed to process this request. We understand that this will need approval from the various departments within the city, and if a hearing before the city council is also required for approval we would request that if needed.









