Requested Encroachment Into West Grand Blvd. At 2746 West Grand Blvd. (With

Elevated Pedestrian Walkway)

We have reviewed the above Petition received by this office. Our records indicate there are water mains and sewers in the area of encroachment. With regard to DWSD's interests, our comments are as follows:

- DWSD requires a minimum of 18 feet clearance from the highest point of the surface to the bottom of bridge.
- Our records show there is a 24" water main is located approx. 69' S. of N. ROW line of Grand Blvd. Also, a 15"x20" sewer is located near the centerline of Grand Blvd. approx. 10' to 11' below ground which was built in 1885. DWSD needs information on the method of construction of bridge footings to avoid impact on DWSD utilities. And due to the age of the sewer we may require the installation of a vibration monitoring meter or line the segment of sewer between the two MHs under the proposed bridge, this can be determined later based on additional information.
- DWSD has no objections to the requested encroachments provided that our comments and the attached Provisions for Encroachment are strictly followed.





PROVISIONS FOR ENCROACHMENT For Petition 1846


Detroit Water and Sewerage (DWSD) agree to the proposed encroachment subject to the fulfilling of the following provisions:

- 1. By approval of this petition the (DWSD) does not waive any of its rights to its facilities located in the right of way, and at all time, DWSD, its agents or employees, shall have the right to enter upon the right of way to maintain, repair, alter, service, inspect, or install its facilities. All costs incident to the damaging, dismantling, demolishing, removal and replacement of structures or other improvements herein permitted and incurred in gaining access to DWSD's facilities for maintenance, repairing, alteration, servicing or inspection caused by the encroachment shall be borne by the petitioner. All costs associated with gaining access to DWSD's facilities, which could normally be expected had the petitioner not encroached into the right of way shall be borne by DWSD.
- 2. DWSD requires a vertical clearance of 18 feet above grade for maintenance excess and repair.
- 3. All construction performed under this petition shall not be commenced until after five (5) days written notice to DWSD. Seventy-two (72) hours notice shall also be provided in accordance with P.A. 53 1974, as amended, utilizing the MISS DIG one call system.
- 4. Construction under this petition is subject to inspection and approval by DWSD forces. The cost of such inspection shall, at the discretion of DWSD, be borne by the petitioner.
- 5. If DWSD facilities located within the right of way shall break or be damaged as the result of any action on the part of the petitioner, then in such event the petitioner agrees to be liable for all costs incident to the repair, replacement or relocation of such broken or damaged DWSD facilities.
- 6. The petitioner shall hold DWSD harmless for any damage to the encroaching device constructed or installed under this petition, which may be caused by the failure of DWSD's facilities.

PETITION - Encroachment of Elevated Pedestrian Walkway

Henry Ford Health System (HFHS), is hereby submitting this petition for your approval of street right-of-way encroachments for the Elevated Pedestrian Walkway that will connect the existing Henry Ford Hospital to the new Henry Ford Cancer Project (recently named the Brigitte Harris Cancer Pavilion) over West Grand Boulevard. HFHS is proposing the pedestrian bridge for the safety and convenience of patients, staff and visitors to both facilities.

The current legal land use of the proposed Cancer Project site is Vacant Land. The property is zoned B5 (Major Business) Zoning District. The proposed uses of the Cancer Project include Office, Parking and ground floor commercial space, which are by-right uses per Sections 61-9-95(10), 61-9-96(24) and 61-9-96(26) of the Zoning Ordinance.

The Henry Ford Cancer Project site plan was approved on March 29, 2017 and meets the site plan requirements of Section 61-3-151 of the Detroit Zoning Ordinance.

HFHS hereby requests the following right-of-way encroachments in connection with the proposed Elevated Pedestrian Walkway:

WEST GRAND BOULEVARD

- HFHS hereby requests a 16' wide x 19' high encroachment approximately 18' above West Grand Boulevard into the right-of-way across West Grand Boulevard between West Milwaukee Ave. and Lincoln Street (between where Sterling Street and Trumbull Ave. previously connected with W. Grand Blvd). Refer to attached Site Plan and cross section Exhibit A.
- 2. HFHS hereby requests a 16' wide x 9'-6" deep encroachment into the right-of-way on the South side of West Grand Boulevard between West Milwaukee Ave. and Lincoln Street for the structural support of the elevated pedestrian walkway. The proposed distance from the back of curb to structural support is 10'-0". Refer to attached Site Plan and cross section Exhibit A.
- 3. HFHS hereby requests a 16' wide x 8'-0" deep encroachment into the right-of-way on the North side of West Grand Boulevard between West Milwaukee Ave. and Lincoln Street for the structural support of the Elevated Pedestrian Walkway. The proposed distance from the back of curb to structural support is 12'-0". Refer to attached Site Plan and cross section Exhibit A.

1 Ford Place, 4A Detroit, MI 48202-3450 (313)-874-5432 Office (313)-874-4035 Fax The proposed Elevated Pedestrian Walkway exceeds the Detroit Fire Department, Fire Marshall Division minimum required vertical clearance of 13'-6" for the proposed Elevated Pedestrian Walkway. Refer to attached Site Plan and cross section Exhibit A.

Henry Ford Health System understands the proposed support structures located in the public right-of-way (West Grand Boulevard) will require a maintenance agreement and permit by the Department of Public Works, City Engineering Division along with encroachment approval from Detroit City Council.

Henry Ford will enter into an Indemnity Agreement with the City of Detroit with the City's standard form.

We are hereby submitting this petition requesting your approval of the street right of way encroachment. Thank you for your assistance on this matter.

### LEGAL DESCRIPTION: ELEVATED PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY

An elevated pedestrian walkway is proposed to span across the existing Right—of—Way of West Grand Boulevard (150 feet wide) to connect Henry Ford Health Systems facilities on opposite sides of the aforementioned West Grand Boulevard Right—of—Way. The limits of the pedestrian walkway are separated into three (3) regions: (1) Skywalk Tower South, (2) Skywalk and (3) Skywalk Tower North. Each region is described using minimum and maximum elevations representing the upper and lower bounds of the walkway structure as well as traditional metes and bounds courses. The pedestrian walkway is described as follows:

### SKYWALK TOWER SOUTH:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 29 of "Lothrop & Duffield Land Co. Ltd.'s Sub", as recorded in Liber 23 of Plats, Page 38, Wayne County Records, Wayne County, Michigan, also being the Southwest corner of the intersection of West Grand Boulevard (150 feet wide) and Sterling Avenue (variable width); thence N62*13'54"E 96.08 feet along the Southerly Right-of-Way line of said West Grand Boulevard to a PLACE OF BEGINNING of SKYWALK TOWER SOUTH, being bound between elevations 152.50 feet and 189.50 feet (City of Detroit Vertical Datum) representing the lower and upper bounds of the structure; thence N27*46'16"W 9.50 feet to REFERENCE POINT "A"; thence N62*13'54"E 16.00 feet; thence S27*46'16"E 9.50 feet; thence S62*13'54"W 16.00 feet along the Southerly Right-of-Way line of said West Grand Boulevard to the Point of Beginning, being a part of Fractional Section 36, T1S, R11E, City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan.

### SKYWALK:

BEGINNING at the aforementioned REFERENCE POINT "A", the SKYWALK is bound between elevations 170.50 feet and 189.50 feet (City of Detroit Vertical Datum), representing the lower and upper bounds of the structure; thence N27*46'16"W 132.50 feet to REFERENCE POINT "B"; thence N62*13'54"E 16.00 feet; thence S27*46'16"E 132.50 feet; thence S62*13'54"W 16.00 feet to the Point of Beginning, being a part of Fractional Section 36, T1S, R11E and part of Quarter Section 55 of the 10,000 Acre Tract, Recorded in Liber 6 of Deeds, Page 189, City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan.

### SKYWALK TOWER NORTH

BEGINNING at the aforementioned REFERENCE POINT "B", the SKYWALK TOWER NORTH is bound between elevations 152.50 feet and 193.50 feet (City of Detroit Vertical Datum), representing the lower and upper bounds of the structure; thence S62°13′54″W 2.50 feet; thence N27°46′16″W 8.00 feet; thence N62°13′52″E 21.00 feet along the Northerly Right—of—Way line of said West Grand Boulevard; thence S27°46′16″E 8.00 feet; thence S62°13′54″W 18.50 feet to the Point of Beginning, being a part of Quarter Section 55 of the 10,000 Acre Tract, Recorded in Liber 6 of Deeds, Page 189, City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan.
