We, the undersigned entities owning property adjacent to the following proposed alley and public easement vacations have no objections to the request of the petitioner.

- 1. Outright vacate the public alley (20 feet wide) in the block bounded by Rivard Street (66 feet wide), Hendrie Street (66 feet wide), Russell Street (80 feet wide) and E Ferry Street (60 feet wide).




