

On behalf of Selden Innovation Center, LLC, we would like to petition the City of Detroit for the conversion to easement of that portion of Frank Street located between the John C Lodge Service Drive and the western edge of the alley first west of 4th Street, as well as the East-West alley located between the John C Lodge Service Drive, Alexandrine Street, 4th Street, and Frank Street.

Both the street closure and the alley closure are part of a larger redevelopment plan for the former Jefferson School building. The purpose of the closure of Frank Street is to allow for a pedestrian connection between the existing building and the proposed parking lot, and the purpose of the alley closure is to allow for consolidation of the proposed parking lot.
