



On behalf of Frontier Developments, LLC, we would like to petition the City of Detroit for the conversion to easement of that portion of Pittsburg Avenue east of Livernois, that portion of Military Street north of McGraw, and the north-south alley located between Pittsburg, Military, McGraw, and Livernois. Please see the attached ALTA survey for reference.
