Re: Petiton for outright vacation of the dead-end portion of Western St south of McGraw St and a portion of McGraw St directly west and adjacent to Western St south of McGraw St.



Honorable City Council,

I am writing with a request to outright vacate the dead-end portion of Western St south of McGraw St and a portion of McGraw St directly west and adjacent to Western St south of McGraw St. This right of way is directly adjacent to the existing DTE McGraw substation (9400 McGraw St) to the east and directly adjacent to parcels to the west that DTE is working with the City of Detroit and MDOT to obtain to expand McGraw substation. This portion of Western St is a dead end and not used for vehicular/pedestrian traffic. DTE Energy will also work with all existing utilities impacted to make arrangements for relocation/private easements as necessary.

The expansion of McGraw substation is required to address 7,000 City of Detroit and Dearborn customers who have been placed on temporary electrical facilities due to severe equipment damage resulting from the June rainstorms that caused drastic flooding in the area, including the sub-basement and basement of the existing McGraw substation. The vacated portions of Western St and a portion of McGraw St will be combined with parcels to the west being acquired from the City of Detroit and MDOT, along with the existing McGraw substation property into one contiguous parcel. This expanded property will allow DTE to install new electrical infrastructure to place the affected customers back on permanent elelectrical utility power.


The portion of McGraw St requested to be vacated is currently a DDOT bus stop. As a part of this project, DTE will work with DDOT to relocate the bus stop to a suitable area just east of McGraw substation.



A parcel of land being part of Western Street, 50 feet wide, and part of McGraw Street, variable width, and contained in the SULLIVAN AND RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION of the West 944 Acres of Private Claim 40, North of Michigan Avenue, Springwells Township (now City of Detroit), Wayne County Michigan, being more particularly described as:

Commencing at the Northwesterly Corner of Private Claim 40; thence North 13°29'00" East, 29.60 feet along the Northerly line of said Private Claim 40 to a point on the South line of McGraw Street, variable width; thence North 85°00'58" East, 12.86 feet along said South line of McGraw Street to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**; thence continuing along said South line North 85°00'58" East, 83.53 feet to the Westerly line of Western Street, 50 feet wide; thence South 31°44'00" East, 77.54 feet along said Westerly line of Western Street also being the Easterly line of part of Lot 83, Lot 84 and Lot 85, and part of Lot 86 of said SULLIVAN AND RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION; thence North 58°16'00" East, 50.00 feet to the Easterly line of said Western Street and the Southwest corner of Lot 71 of said SULLIVAN AND RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION; thence North 31°44'00" West, 117.37 feet along the Easterly line of said Western Street, also being the Westerly line of Lots 71 to 74, inclusive, of said SULLIVAN AND RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION to the Southerly line of McGraw Street, variable width, said point being 2.63 feet southerly of the Northwest corner of Lot 74; thence South 57°14'28" West, 124.61 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 0.168 acres of land, more or less.


