RE: Giffels Webster - Request a series of vacations within the block bounded by Dalzelle Street (Variable Width), 15th Street (60 feet wide), 14th Street (80 feet wide), and Marantette Street (60 feet wide).

Giffels Webster, 28 W. Adams, Suite 1200, Detroit, Michigan 48226 on behalf of Ford Motor Company, 1 American Rd., Dearborn, MI respectfully requests the following outright vacations within the block bounded by Dalzelle Street (Variable Width), 15th Street (60 feet wide), 14th Street (80 feet wide), and Marantette Street (60 feet wide):

- Outright vacation 10.0 feet into the southern Dalzelle Street (variable width) public right-of-way beginning at the western 14th Street (80 feet wide) right-of-way and extending 145.0 feet west.
- Outright vacation of the 20.0-foot-wide alley from the southern Dalzelle Street (variable width) extending 80.0 feet south to the existing easement established on September 16, 1969, J.C.C. pgs. 2354-5.
- Vacation of the easement established on September 16, 1969, J.C.C. pgs. 2354-5.
- Vacation of ingress/egress easement established on August 20, 1935.

See attached exhibit for further clarification. Giffels Webster has been asked to facilitate the requested vacations. We will be working with the City of Detroit's Department of Public Works – Civil Engineering Division, and all stakeholders to achieve vacations that are satisfactory to all interested parties.

The requested vacation will neither impede pedestrian and vehicular traffic, nor will it interfere with the maintenance of the public rights-of-way, including utility company and Fire and Police Department access.
