RE: Giffels Webster - Request for an encroachment into the right-of-way of 15th Street (60 ft. wide) between Dalzelle St and Marantette St.

Giffels Webster, 28 W. Adams, Suite 1200, Detroit, Michigan 48226 on behalf of Ford Land 330 Town Center Drive, Suite 1100, Dearborn, Michigan, 48126-2738 respectfully requests the following encroachments into the City of Detroit public right-of-way.

- Encroachments include:
 - Below grade encroachments:
 - The below grade encroachment is for a seasonally used irrigation line. The irrigation line is a privately owned 1-inch in diameter line that is housed in a 6-inch sleeve. The encroachment begins **79.2 ft** South of the property line at the Southeast corner of 15th Street and Dalzelle St. The encroachment then extends South 1.5 ft. The encroachment spans from the right-of-way on the East of 15th Street to the right-of-way on the West of 15th Street. This means the encroachment 60 feet across. The encroachment begins 0.5 feet below grade and extends to 1.5 ft below grade.


Limits of the requested encroachments can be found in the attachment, enclosed herein. Additional documentation to provide further detail about the encroachment for the irrigation line are attached.
