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## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT OF DECEMBER 6, 1957

This Agreement made this 1911 day of Archerica 1961, by and between the CITY OF DETROIT, a municipal corporation, by its duly authorized officer, and THE DETROIT BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, a Michigan banking corporation of Detroit, Michigan, amends agreement made by and between the aforesaid parties dated December 6, 1957, and involving excess land in the block bounded by Fort, Wayne (now Washington Boulevard), Congress and Shelby Streets in the City of Detroit, Michigan.

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of December, 1957, the City of Detroit agreed to sell to The Detroit Bank and Trust Company surplus real property in the block bounded by Fort, Wayne (now Washington Boulevard), Congress and Shelby Streets in Detroit, Michigan, and entered into a written agreement to that effect containing the conditions upon which the property would be sold; and

WHEREAS, said The Detroit Bank and Trust Company has altered its plans for the construction of a building on the premises and desires to change the conditions contained in the original agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Detroit approved the changes in said agreement, May 25, 1961 (J.C.C. p. 1129);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED by and between the parties hereto that the agreement of December 6, 1957 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

BERNARD J. YOUNGBLOOD, Righter of Deeds

Subsection 1 of the First Section after the word Provided be amended to read as follows:

1. That, in addition to the 80-foot right-of-way now existing on Wayne Street (now Washington Boulevard) which provides for two 10-foot margins for public sidewalks, 3 feet of building setback be provided on the east side of Wayne Street (now Washington Boulevard) between Fort Street and the alley (now vacated) immediately south thereof, and that this building setback be extended in a straight line to the Congress Street right-of-way, as per the attached plan, made a part hereof.

Subsection 2 of the First Section after the word Provided be amended to read as follows:

2. That the westerly 3 feet of the property acquired by The Detroit Bank and Trust Company from the City of Detroit, by a deed pursuant to this agreement, be used for public sidewalk purposes in conjunction with the 10-foot sidewalk which will be constructed by the City immediately adjoining said 3-foot strip on the west.

Subsection 3 of the First Section after the word Provided be amended to read as follows:

3. That the wedge-shaped piece of property remaining, lying between the 3-foot strip mentioned in Paragraph 2 above, and the proposed building line mentioned in Paragraph 1 above, shall be landscaped by The Detroit Bank and Trust Company; and that said landscaping plans be submitted for review to the City Plan Commission of the City of Detroit in order that said plans may conform to landscaping plans proposed by the City for the west side of Wayne Street (now Washington Boulevard) in the blocks north and south of Congress Street.

Further, that the Second section be amended to read as

## follows:

SECOND: That in the event of default by The Detroit Bank and Trust Company in its covenants hereunder, the City of Detroit shall have the right to demand a deed to the said 3-foot strip to be used for public sidewalk along the westerly side of the three parcels of land hereinabove described.

In all other respects said agreement between the parties dated December 6, 1957, shall remain in full force and effect.

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
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
