CONSENT JUDGMENT TO VACATE A 50-FOOT WIDE PORTION OF WESTERN STREET AND AN EIGHT-FOOT WIDE PORTION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY, SULLIVAN & RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION OF THE WEST 9.44 ACRES OF P.C. 40 NORTH OF MICHIGAN AVE. IN THE CITY OF DETROIT

At a session of said Court held in the City of Detroit, Wayne County, State of Michigan, this 29th day of May, 2024.

PRESENT: HONORABLE ANNETTE J. BERRY Circuit Court Judge

Plaintiff, DTE Electric Company ("DTE"), a Michigan corporation, having filed its Complaint to Vacate a 50-Foot Wide Portion of Western Street and an Eight-Foot Wide Portion of a Public Alley, Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave. in the City of Detroit, and Plaintiff having represented to this Court that all parties required by MCL 560.224a(1) to be joined have been so joined, and it appearing that those parties have been given notice of the proceedings leading to this Consent Judgment and have either been

defaulted, consented to the vacation as requested in the Complaint, or stipulated to a Consent Judgment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED and ADJUDGED:

- 1. The City of Detroit Council in public session on January 27, 2022, (Petition No. x2022-35) adopted a Resolution consenting to the vacation of a 50-foot wide portion of Western Street in Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave. per Liber 14, Page 91, located in the City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan ("Vacated Portion of Western Street"). A copy of the Petition is attached as Exhibit A. A copy of the Plat map of Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave. is attached as Exhibit B.
- 2. The Vacated Portion of Western Street is more particularly described as follows:

A PARCEL OF LAND BEING PART WESTERN STREET, 50 FEET WIDE, AND CONTAINED IN THE PLAT OF SULLIVAN & RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN LIBER 14 OF PLATS, PAGE 91, WAYNE COUNTY RECORDS. BEING PART OF PRIVATE CLAIM 40, NORTH OF MICHIGAN AVENUE, T2S-R11E, CITY OF DETROIT, WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS:

COMMENCING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID PRIVATE CLAIM 40; THENCE N13°29'00"E 29.59 FEET, ALONG THE NORTHERLY LINE OF SAID PRIVATE CLAIM TO THE SOUTHERLY RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF MCGRAW STREET; THENCE ALONG SAID RIGHT OF WAY THE FOLLOWING TWO COURSES: N85°00'59"E 20.82 FEET AND N57°22'18"E 64.35 FEET TO THE WEST LINE OF WESTERN STREET AND THE POINT OF BEGINNING (BEING A POINT ON E LINE OF LOT 82 OF SAID PLAT THAT IS S31°36'10"E 14.57' FROM N COR OF SAID LOT 82); THENCE S31°36'10"W 105.44 FEET TO THE SE COR OF LOT 85 OF SAID PLAT AND NORTHERN LIMITED ACCESS RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF I-94; THENCE N70°51'04"E 51.21 FEET ALONG SAID RIGHT OF WAY LINE TO THE EAST LINE OF WESTERN STREET; THENCE N31°36'10"W ALONG SAID LINE 117.38 FEET TO THE SOUTH

RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF MCGRAW STREET AT A POINT ON W LINE OF LOT 74 THAT IS S31°36'10"E 2.63' FROM NW COR OF SAID LOT 74; THENCE S57°22'18"W 50.01 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. CONTAINS 0.13 ACRE OF LAND, MORE OR LESS.

The Vacated Portion of Western Street is depicted on the drawing attached as Exhibit C.

- 3. The City of Detroit Council in public session on June 15, 2023, (Petition No. x2023-239) adopted a Resolution consenting to the vacation of an eight-foot wide portion of a public alley in Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave. per Liber 14, Page 91, located in the City of Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan ("Vacated Portion of the Public Alley"). A copy of the Petition is attached as Exhibit D.
- 4. The Vacated Portion of the Public Alley is more particularly described as follows:

A PARCEL OF LAND BEING ALL THAT PART OF A PUBLIC ALLEY, 8 FEET WIDE, AND BEING WESTERLY OF, AND ADJACENT TO THE WEST LINE OF LOTS 82-85 IN THE PLAT OF SULLIVAN & RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN LIBER 14 OF PLATS, PAGE 91, WAYNE COUNTY RECORDS. BEING PART OF PRIVATE CLAIM 40, NORTH OF MICHIGAN AVENUE, T2S-R11E, CITY OF DETROIT, WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS:

PART OF THE PLAT OF SULLIVAN & RUSSELL'S SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN LIBER 14 OF PLATS, PAGE 91, WAYNE COUNTY RECORDS. BEING PART OF PRIVATE CLAIM 40, NORTH OF MICHIGAN AVENUE, SPRINGWELLS, T2S-R11E, CITY OF DETROIT, WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS BEGINNING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID PRIVATE CLAIM 40; THENCE \$31°23'50"E, ALONG THE WESTERLY LINE OF SAID PLAT, 66.73 FEET TO THE NORTHERLY LIMITED ACCESS RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF I-94 FREEWAY; THENCE ALONG SAID RIGHT OF WAY LINE N72°24'41"E 8.24 FEET TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOTS 85-82, 76.73 FEET TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOTS 85-82, 76.73 FEET TO THE WESTERLY SUBDIVISION LINE AND THE NORTHERLY LINE OF PRIVATE CLAIM 40; THENCE \$13°29'00"W, ALONG SAID SUB LINE AND NORTHERLY P.C. LINE, 11.34 FEET TO THE POINT OF

BEGINNING. CONTAINS 574 SQUARE FEET OF LAND, MORE OR LESS.

The Vacated Portion of the Public Alley is depicted on the drawing attached as Exhibit C.

- 5. Upon entry of this Consent Judgment and recordation of the amended plat, the Vacated Portion of Western Street is hereby vacated. Title to the Vacated Portion of Western Street shall vest in Plaintiff as set forth in MCL 560.277a(3).
- 6. Upon entry of this Consent Judgment and recordation of the amended plat, the Vacated Portion of the Public Alley is hereby vacated. Title to the Vacated Portion of the Public Alley shall vest in Plaintiff as set forth in MCL 560.277a(2).
- 7. Portions of Lots 74 and 82, as described and depicted on attached Exhibit C, being used as public street, being subject to an existing street by City of Detroit resolution, is hereby confirmed and established in conformance with MCL 560.137, to be depicted as a portion of the public right-of-way for McGraw Street that burdens these portions of the plat. This right-of-way shall remain under the jurisdiction of the City of Detroit.
- 8. The part of Lot 85, as described and depicted on attached Exhibit C, being used as public highway according to Liber 9051, Page 540, Wayne County Records, is hereby confirmed and established in conformance with MCL 560.137, to be depicted as a portion of the public right-of-way for Highway I-94 that burdens these portions of the plat. This right-of-way shall remain under the jurisdiction of the MDOT.
- 9. The Vacated Portion of Western Street, the Vacated Portion of the Public Alley, and Lots 71-74 and 82-85, except for the above described part of Lots 74, 82 and 85 that are confirmed and/or established as public right of way for McGraw Street and/or Highway I-94, shall be consolidated into one lot to be identified by the first available consecutive lot number in

Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave. on an amended plat, and title to this consolidated lot is vested in the Plaintiff.

- 10. The parties acknowledge and agree that Plaintiff intends to install improvements within the Vacated Portion of Western Street and the Vacated Portion of the Public Alley ("Plaintiff's Improvements").
- Judgment that are located within the boundary of the amended plat are preserved, and the amended plat shall show only recorded easements, and shall be accompanied by a written statement of the surveyor that he or she, in determining the type, width, and location of any recorded easements shown has reviewed any existing title search and/or policy of title insurance and has searched, or caused to be searched, the records of the Register of Deeds for any recorded easements burdening the subject lands which were created between the date of a title search or issuance of a title policy and the most recent submittal date of the amended plat and shall provide a copy of those records to the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Office of Land Survey and Remonumentation ("OLSR") upon submission of the amended plat.
- 12. Plaintiff shall record this Consent Judgment with the Office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Wayne, State of Michigan, as required by MCL 560.228. A copy of the recorded Consent Judgment shall accompany the amended plat to be filed with the OLSR. Plaintiff shall deliver to the City Attorney's Office a recorded copy of this Consent Judgment within thirty (30) days after it has been entered by the Court.
- 13. Plaintiff shall prepare an amended plat of Lots 71, 72, 73, 74, 82, 83, 84 and 85 and the adjacent Vacated Portion of Western Street and the Vacated Portion of the Public Alley in Sullivan & Russell's Subdivision of the West 9.44 Acres of P.C. 40 North of Michigan Ave.

affected by this Consent Judgment within 90 days of the entry of this Consent Judgment and shall submit the amended plat for review and approval of the OLSR. The amended plat shall be consistent with this Consent Judgment, in substantial compliance with <u>Exhibit C</u> and shall be in a form that complies with the Michigan Land Division Act, MCL 560.101, et. seq.

14. Upon notice and hearing, this Consent Judgment shall be declared null and void *nunc pro tunc* should the amended plat not be prepared and filed as required by this Consent Judgment and by the requirements of the Land Division Act within 90 days from the entry of this Consent Judgment

15. This resolves the last pending claim in this matter and closes this case except as may be necessary to enforce the provisions of this Consent Judgment.
