Re: petition for vacation of right-of-way

I am petitioning the City to vacate the lot immediately to the west of the property at 5001 Grand River Avenue. The lot is currently listed in City records as  $17^{th}$  Street, but it is separated from  $17^{th}$  Street and bounded on all sides: the south side is bounded by the sidewalk along W Warren Avenue, the east side is bounded by the building at 5001 Grand River Avenue, and the north and west sides are bounded by elevated train tracks. The lot is intended to be used for parking by tenants renting space in the building at 5001 Grand River Avenue, and there is an existing curb cut in the sidewalk along W Warren Avenue allowing vehicular access to the lot. A chain link fence with a gate was erected along the edge of the W Warren Avenue sidewalk, separating the lot from the sidewalk.



Re: petition for encroachment into the right-of-way

I am petitioning the City for permission to install an ADA-compliant ramp that encroaches into the right of way along the south side of the building at 5001 Grand River Avenue. The building has two existing entrances – on at the corner of Grand River Ave and W Warren Ave, one on the south side on W Warren Ave – but both are significantly above grade and so do not meet accessibility requirements. I propose to install a ramp to access the south entrance on W Warren Avenue. The ramp will be a steel structure, anchored to the existing sidewalk with expansion bolts, designed and built to meet ADA and Code requirements for accessibility. The sidewalk along W Warren Avenue adjacent to the building is approximately eighteen and a half feet (18.5') wide, and the ramp structure will project less than five and a half feet (5.5') from the building face, leaving more than thirteen feet (13') of unobstructed sidewalk width.




