Dear Petition Clerk:

Environmental Resources Group (ERG) has been retained by BPH, LLC to conduct an environmental investigation to address releases from underground storage tanks (USTs) at their facility, Suzy Fuel Mart located at 6011 Livernois (Parcel ID: 18006950) (Site). ERG is respectfully requesting permission on behalf of BPH, LLC to install in-boring soil gas points and monitoring wells in the alleyway west of the Site, in the Right-of-Way (ROW) on the north side of Barlum, and in the ROW on the west side of Livernois. Access to the gas points and wells is needed until requisite site closure activities under Part 213, 1994, P.A 451, as amended, for the release at Suzy Fuel Mart, release number REL-0241-22. BPH, LLC, or its authorized agent/representative will take reasonable precautions to minimize damage to these areas and all equipment will be removed unless it can be safely abandoned in place beneath the surface of the property upon site closure.

Upon your approval, BPH, LLC or its authorized representative will submit all required




Typical Monitoring Well Construction Detail
