Re: E-Plans Review for the Arts Alleys Project North End Arts Alley

On behalf of the City of Detroit's Office of Art, Culture, and Entrepreneurship (ACE), OHM Advisors is submitting construction plans for review and approval by the various City Departments. The proposed project includes the activation of an existing alleyway for the creation of shared public spaces to celebrate neighborhoods and promote the installation of art. The improvements noted within this submittal include the infrastructure elements to renew the alleys; making them accessible and safe for pedestrians.

The scope of work necessary for this project will include the following:

- · Alley vegetation clearing and disposal of debris
- Drainage improvements with the installation of new catch basins and adjusting existing manholes to grade.
- Removal and replacement of alley pavements with concrete and decorative concrete.
- Installation of a landscaping adjacent to the alley on property owned by Oakland Avenue Community Farms.
- · Installation of solar powered lighting.
- Installation of an electrical service.

Alley Use

As part of this project, the existing public alley parallel to Oakland Avenue between Owen and Westminster will be improved. This will include new concrete pavement protected on each end with removable bollards which will protect the space for pedestrian use as intended. The edges of this new space will include movable benches. The alley will be marked with the installation of decorative ACE Arts Alley signage.

Based on the proposed improvements, ACE will be submitting encroachment petitions denoting the above noted non-typical items within the east-west alley. The encroachment petition will also include written consent from property owners adjoining the alleyways. In addition, a separate standard DPW maintenance agreement will be provided documenting the improvements.

Adjacent Improvements

The plans depict improvements on a number of adjacent properties. Specifically, there will be fencing improvements to better define the alleyway. In addition, landscape plantings will be placed adjacent to the alley on private property.
