On behalf of Detroit Art, Culture, and Entrepreneurship, OHM Advisors is writing this cover letter in response to the comments received by the City of Detroit's Department of Public Works in regard to the upcoming Arts Alleys project. The proposed Bagley Arts Alley streetscaping project is located within the alley southwest of Bagley and 18th Street from Wing Pl to Bagley St.

Within the alley right of way (ROW), the existing concrete pavement will be removed and replaced. Outside of the ROW a masonry wall and some fencing is planned for replacement. Other improvements include removable bollards, Arts Alley signage, waste bins, concrete benches, shade canopies and landscaping. We also propose improvements to storm drainage through storm underdrain. The City of Detroit's office of Art, Culture, and Entrepreneurship (ACE) within the City of Detroit's General Services Department will be the owner of the above-referenced Encroachments. ACE will also be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of these encroachments.

DPW Comment Responses:

- Include letters of support from adjacent property owners who will lose access to Bagley through the alley.
 It is unclear which properties you're referencing. The proposed improvements do not modify current accessibility to the Bagley Alley. Proposed bollards are collapsible/removable. The proposed masonry will replace the existing wall. The fencing improvements apply only to properties who already have fences.
- The bollards and benches may proceed in this review, however the proposed wall and canopy would be considered a structures and are prohibited from encroaching into the public right of way.
 In previous discussions with the DPW, no objections were given to the overhead structure. These meetings included Director Brundidge and Pamela Lemme.

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
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
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
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
