Petition Number x2024 -343--General Services Department, request to dedicate RE: land, commonly known as Jerome Avenue from Dequindre Ave. to Goddard Street, Jerome Avenue from Goddard Street to East McNichols Road and Detroit Terminal Railroad from DGH&M Railroad to Dequindre Ave. for the purpose of public Rightof-Way.

Petition Number x2024 -343--General Services Department, request to dedicate land, commonly known as Jerome Avenue from Dequindre Ave. to Goddard Street, Jerome Street from Goddard Street to East McNichols Road and Detroit Terminal Railroad from DGH&M Railroad to Dequindre Ave. for the purpose of public Right-of-Way.

The petition was referred to the City Engineering Division - DPW for investigation (utility clearance) and report. This is our report.

This request comes as part of the Joe Louis Greenway project.

All other city departments and utilities have reported no objections to the proposed rightof-way dedication.

PROVIDED, that General Services Division is responsible for the construction and maintenance of all improvements within the land dedicated in this resolution. Including, but not limited to, grading, landscaping, irrigation, and lighting.

PROVIDED, that General Services Division is responsible for all waste or blight removal within the land leing dedicated in this resolution.


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
