AECOM proposes the advancement of 13 soil borings to be developed into monitoring wells and soil gas wells (2 monitoring wells in the ROW west of Wyoming Avenue, north of West McNichols Road, 2 monitoring well in the ROW south of West McNichols Road, east of Wyoming Avenue, and 5 monitoring wells with 3 soil gas wells in the alley north of 8930 West McNichols Road, and 1 soil gas well west of Kentucky Street, north of the alley). Please refer to the site map of the proposed locations.

All monitoring wells and soil gas wells will be permanent and finished in place with concrete, level with the surrounding area.


All investigation derived waste will be stored at 8930 W. McNichols, Detroit in 55-gallon drums until a waste pickup can be scheduled.

This work is expected to begin approximately 3rd quarter of 2024, pending approval, and be completed within a week of the start date.















TYPICAL MONITORING WELL CONSTRUCTION DIAGRAM
