MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

This agreement	(this "Agreement") is made and entered into this _24th day of
April	2025, by and between the City of Detroit, a Michigan municipal
corporation, actin	ng by and through its Department of Public Works (the "City"), and Bedrock
Real Estate, LLC	, ("Owner") whose address is 630 Woodward Ave., Detroit, MI 48226

NOW THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, including the covenants and undertaking herein contained, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. **Purpose of Agreement:** Owner holds title to a certain parcel described in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto (the "Parcel"). City owns certain property adjacent to the Parcel. Inasmuch as persons entering or exiting from the Parcel may use the City-owned property, and/or to the extent that certain services benefiting the Parcel (for example, water and sewer) are located in the City-owned property, Owner has agreed to improve and maintain a portion of City-owned property in the location (the "Maintenance Area") and manner detailed in the plan attached as <u>Exhibit B</u> for the Term, as defined herein.
- 2. **Financial Responsibility:** It is understood that during the Term, all physical improvements and repairs to the Maintenance Area, as set forth herein, shall be at the sole cost and expense of Owner, subject to any express limitations set forth in this Agreement.
- 3. **Indemnification and Hold Harmless:** Owner hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the City harmless from all loss, costs, expense, actions, claims of action, damages and liability (including attorneys' fees and costs) for injury to or death of any person or persons and for the damage to or destruction of property caused by Owner's actions or omissions in the course of or resulting from the maintenance activities contemplated by this Agreement.
- 4. **Insurance:** Owner covenants and agrees, at its sole cost and expense, to maintain or cause to be maintained for the mutual benefit of it and the City comprehensive general liability insurance on an occurrence form against claims for bodily injuries (including, but not limited to, death) or property damage (including, but not limited to, destruction) at any time occurring in the course of or resulting from work carried out by Owner upon, in or about the Maintenance Area, at combined single limits of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in the aggregate. Such insurance coverage shall name the City of Detroit as an additional insured and shall provide that the same may not be cancelled or materially modified without prior written notice by certified mail to the City to the attention of City of Detroit, Finance Department, Coleman A. Young Municipal

Center, Detroit, MI 48226; Attention: Risk Management Division. Said coverage may be evidenced by a certificate of insurance issued upon so-called "blanket" coverage, or by either a certificate or the original of an insurance policy effecting such coverage. The

insurance shall be primary and any such insurance or self-insurance maintained by the City shall be secondary and non-contributory and excess. Owner shall be responsible for payment of all deductibles relating to such insurance. The provisions requiring Owner to carry or cause to be carried such insurance shall not be constructed as waiving or restricting the liability of Owner under this Agreement.

- 5. **Term:** The term of this Agreement (the "Term") shall commence on the date of this Agreement and continue for five (5) years thereafter unless terminated or extended pursuant to the following:
 - a. The City may terminate this Agreement prior to the end of the Term in the event the City has designed and has committed to implement a uniform scheme for the improvement of an area of City-owned property that encompasses the Maintenance Area and other adjacent City-owned property. The aforesaid may include widening of streets or sidewalks and relocation of water or sewer facilities.
 - b. Owner may terminate this Agreement prior to the end of the Term if it sells or ground leases the Parcel or grants a mortgage lien or security interest in the Parcel or portion thereof.
 - c. In the event a party elects to terminate this Agreement pursuant to Sections 5(a) or 5(b) above, such party shall deliver to the other party written notice of such election at least thirty (30) days prior to the date on which termination shall be effective.
 - d. Following the five-year expiration (but not the early termination) of this Agreement, this Agreement shall automatically continue on month to month basis subject to final termination by either party upon delivery of at least thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party.
- 6. **Governing Law:** This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan.
- 7. **Entire Agreement:** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. Any prior agreements, negotiations or representations not expressly set forth in this Agreement are of no force or effect. Any amendment to or modification of this Agreement shall be of no force or effect unless it is in writing and signed by an authorized signatory for each of the parties.
- 8. Successors and Assigns: This Agreement is for the exclusive benefit of the parties stated herein and shall not be deemed to give any legal or equitable right, remedy or claim whatsoever to any other person. Notwithstanding the aforesaid, Owner shall have the right, without requiring the City's consent to assign this Agreement to any purchaser of the Parcel or any affiliate of Owner; provided that if Owner assigns this Agreement to any unaffiliated third party purchaser of the Parcel, Owner shall notify the City in

writing no later than thirty (30) days after such assignment, and the City may, by written notice to Owner within forty-five (45) days after receiving such notice from Owner (subject to reasonable extension due to City Council recess), terminate this Agreement. Unless terminated as provided above, this Agreement shall be binding upon the parties' successors and assigns.

- 9. **Improvement Changes:** Any changes to the Maintenance Area, except as contemplated by this Agreement, are subject to the prior approval of the City. Owner shall not install or construct in the Maintenance Area any structure, fixture, furniture, or equipment (including but not limited to signs, lighting, fixtures, shades, canopies, or awnings) as may obstruct or in any way encroach upon the Maintenance Area except as set forth in Exhibit B or otherwise properly permitted by the City.
- 10. **Rights of City:** The parties understand that this Agreement in no way limits the property rights of the City with regard to the Maintenance Area.
- 11. Certain Maintenance Obligations of Owner: During the Term, Owner shall be responsible for the improvement and maintenance activities set forth on Exhibit B.

Exhibit A

PARCEL DESCRIPTION

Bedrock Real Estate, LLC, request for several encroachments within the easterly part of Woodward Ave., 120 ft. wide in the block bounded by John R., 60 ft. wide and Grand River Ave., 60 ft. wide, adjacent to the parcel commonly known as 1430 Woodward Ave., for the installation of tree grates, canopies, building lighting, surface mounted bollards, and foundation bollards.

Exhibit B

- 1. Three canopies mounted on the building facade, within Woodward Ave., lying westerly of and adjacent to lots 29 and 30 of "Plan of the Section Numbered Seven" as recorded in Liber 34, Page 544, Wayne County Records. The first canopy shall be installed 5.1' from the southwest corner of the property, 16.7' long and encroaches 5' into the easterly portion of Woodward Ave, 12' to 13' above grade. The second canopy shall be installed 26.9' from the southwest corner of the property, 16.5' long and encroaches 5' into the easterly portion of Woodward Ave., 12' to 13' above grade. The third canopy shall be installed 47.2' from the southwest corner of the property, 16.8' long and encroaches 5' into the easterly portion of Woodward Ave., 12' to 13' above grade.
- 2. Building mounted lighting on the façade that starts at the southwest corner of the property and occurs at four locations along the façade. Said light fixtures will encroach 1.4' into the easterly portion of Woodward Ave., and range from 0' to 13' above grade. The first one is 2' from the southwest corner of the property, then 25' for the second one, the third is 45.3' and the fourth is 66'.
- 3. Security rated bollards starting at the southwest corner of the property and extent 67.2' north to the northwest corner of the property, into the easterly portion of Woodward Ave. There are a total of 12 bollards, located at a distance of 4.4' apart. Said bollards are 1' in diameter and encroach from 4' below grade to 1.67' above grade.
- 4. Surface mounted bollards, total of six that start at the southwest corner of the property and extend 67.2' north to the northwest corner of the property. These bollards will encroach from 4' to 15' into the Woodward Ave. right of way and from 1' below grade to 1.67' above grade.
- 5. Existing tree grates, quantity of four, measuring 5' x 4', all are located 23' in front of the southwest property line, at the property line, the second is 21.5' north of southwest property line, the third is 41.7' north of southwest property line and the fourth is 63.2' north of southwest property line. All existing tree grates are at grade.
- 6. Electrical conduit that starts at the building face and extends 19' to the southwest and 67' from the southwest corner to the northwest corner. Said conduit will be 3' below grade and service the up light in each of the tree planters.

All of the above-described encroachments are within the easterly part Woodward Ave., 120 ft. wide, lying westerly of and adjacent to Lots 29 and 30 of "Plan of the Section Numbered Seven" as recorded in Liber 34, Page 544 of Plats, Wayne County Records.
