**RE: Proposed Scope of Work
13901 Wyoming,
Detroit, Wayne County, Michigan 48238**

AECOM proposes the advancement of 5 soil borings to be developed into monitoring wells (2 monitoring wells in the alley to the west of 13901 Wyoming and 3 within the left turn lane within Schoolcraft Avenue to the south of 13901 Wyoming) An additional soil boring will be completed in the alley to the west of 13901 Wyoming and two soil borings to the east of Wyoming Avenue. An existing monitoring well will also be repaired to the east of Wyoming Avenue. Please refer to the site map for the proposed locations.

AECOM proposes a temporary closure of the left turn lane within Schoolcraft Road south of 13901 Wyoming Avenue for one day in order to complete the work and allow for concrete to set for the permanent monitoring wells.

All monitoring wells will be permanent and finished in place with concrete, level with the surrounding area. Soil borings will also be finished in a similar fashion.

All investigation derived waste will be stored at 13901 Wyoming Avenue, Detroit in 55-gallon drums until a waste pickup can be scheduled.

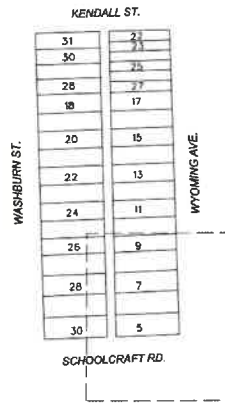
This work is expected to begin approximately 3rd quarter of 2024, pending approval, and be completed within a week of the start date.



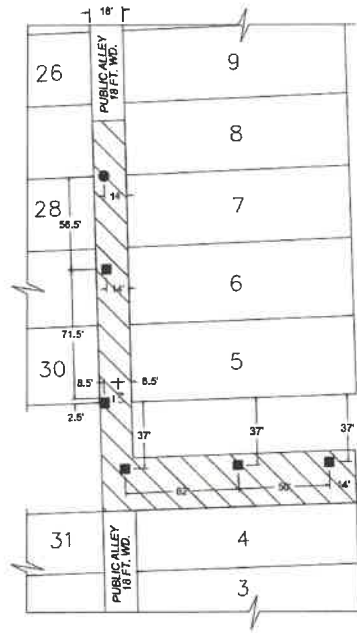
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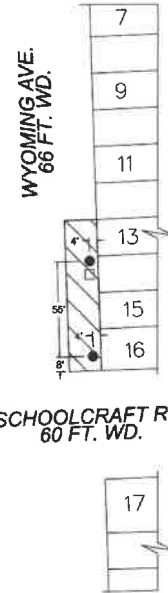
