Street Openings.

If the petitioners were dissatisfied with the assessment roll they should have made their complaint to the Board of Assessors at the time the roll was open for inspection in said office, and having failed to do this, there is no other course to pursue but recommend the denial of the petition which is the recommendation of your Committee.

Ordinances.

To the Honorable the Common Council:

Gentlemen—Your Committee on Ordinances to whom was referred the communication from Hon. Homer Warren, Postmaster, calling attention to the importance and necessity of changing the names of streets in the territory annexed to the City of Detroit on April 1st last, where the names are a duplication of street names within the former limits of the City, beg leave to report that we have had this matter under consideration and desire to state that we instructed the Secretary of Common Council Committee to take the matter up with the City Engineer or other city officers interested and suggest such changes as in their judgment seem meet and proper in the premises. The following is their report:

To the Committee on Ordinances:

Gentlemen—As directed by your Committee on communication from Hon. Homer Warren, Postmaster, in relation to changing names of streets and highways in the territory annexed to the City of Detroit on April 1st last, which now comprises the Eighteenth Ward, where the names are a duplication of street names within the former limits of the City of Detroit, we desire to state that we have carefully reviewed the entire situation and recommend the changing of approximately 125 street names, 100 of which exist in the newly annexed territory.

We also recommend changing the names of approximately 25 streets

within the old corporate limits because of the names being a duplication of names of streets in the new territory, others because of their similarity, and others because of the probability of their never being opened all of which changes appear in the list hereto attached which has been incorporated in the form of an ordinance.

While the new names suggested for certain streets may not meet with the approbation of all interested property owners and residents, some name had to be substituted, and this has been done in as careful a manner as possible whether the street located in the new territory had to be changed or whether it was within the old corporate city limits. The relative importance of one street as against another was given due consideration, and to this end we have exerted our best efforts.

Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE changing the names of certain streets and highways within the corporate limits of the City of Detroit.

It is hereby ordained by the people of the City of Detroit:

Section 1. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit heretofore known as Willson Avenue, extending from Livernois Avenue to westerly city limits, be and the same is hereby designated and shall hereafter be known as Walton Avenue.

Sec. 2. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit, heretofore known as Bitburg Avenue, be and the same is hereby designated and shall be hereafter known as Pittsburg Avenue.

Sec. 3. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit, heretofore known as Joy Street, extending east and west of Lumley Avenue, be and the same is hereby designated and shall be hereafter known as Whitehead Avenue.

Sec. 4. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit heretofore known as Whitwood Avenue, extending west of Livernois Avenue, be and the same is hereby designated and shall be hereafter known as Whitehead Avenue.

Sec. 5. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit heretofore known as Field street, extending from Livernois Avenue to Martin Street, be and the same is hereby designated and shall be hereafter known as Horatio Street.

Sec. 6. That the name of the street and highway in the City of Detroit heretofore known as Harry Street,

5 avenue, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Cyprus Street.

Sec. 7. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Linzee Street,
4 extending east and west of Lumley
5 Avenue, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Malta Street.

Sec. 8. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Emerson
4 Street, extending west of Martin
5 Avenue, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Waldo Avenue.

Sec. 9. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Portland Street
4 extending east of Central Avenue,
5 be and the same is hereby designat-
6 ed and shall be hereafter known as
7 Edward Avenue.

Sec. 10. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Bark-
4 ume Street, be and the same is
5 hereby designated and shall be
6 hereafter known as Otis Street.

Sec. 11. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Bell
4 street, be and the same is hereby
5 designated and shall be hereafter
6 known as Belle avenue.

Sec. 12. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as To-
4 ledo avenue, extending west of Dix
5 avenue, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Ferndale avenue.

Sec. 13. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as
4 Romeyn avenue, extending from
5 Springwells to Lawndale avenues, be
6 and the same is hereby designated
7 and shall be known as Whittaker
8 avenue.

Sec. 14. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Sten-
4 ton avenue, be and the same is here-
5 by designated and shall be hereafter
6 known as Stratton avenue.

Sec. 15. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Mc-
4 Millan avenue, extending from
5 Springwells to Lawndale avenues, be
6 and the same is hereby designated
7 and shall be hereafter known as
8 Senator avenue.

Sec. 16. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Miller
4 avenue, extending from Lawndale to
5 Elsmere avenues, be and the same
6 is hereby designated and shall be
7 hereafter known as Mandale avenue.

Sec. 17. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Fisher
4 avenue, extending east of Spring-
5 wells avenue, be and the same is
6 hereby designated and shall be here-
7 after known as Gartner avenue.

Sec. 18. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Davis
4 avenue, extending from Infantry to
5 Waterman avenues, be and the same
6 is hereby designated and shall be

7 hereafter known as Desmond ave-
8 nue.

Sec. 19. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Lin-
4 coln avenue, extending from Spring-
5 wells to Lawndale avenues, be and
6 the same is hereby designated and
7 shall be hereafter known as Logan
8 avenue.

Sec. 20. That the name of the
2 street and highway in the City of
3 Detroit, heretofore known as Flor-
4 ence avenue, extending from Lawndale
5 to Woodmere avenues, be and
6 the same is hereby designated and
7 shall be hereafter known as Falcon
8 avenue.

Sec. 21. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as Alice avenue, ex-
4 tending from Lawndale to Woodmere
5 avenues, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Longworth avenue.

Sec. 22. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as O'Sullivan avenue,
4 extending from Springwells to Lawndale
5 avenues, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Longworth avenue.

Sec. 23. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as Chandler avenue,
4 extending from Beard avenue to Ker-
5 cheval avenue, be and the same is
6 hereby designated and shall be here-
7 after known as Chatfield avenue.

Sec. 24. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as Regular avenue
4 extending from Beard to Kercheval
5 avenues, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Rowan avenue.

Sec. 25. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as Baker street, ex-
4 tending east of Springwells avenue,
5 be and the same is hereby designated
6 and shall hereafter be known as Bank
7 street.

Sec. 26. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Washington
4 avenue, extending from Springwells to
5 Lawndale avenues, be and the same
6 is hereby designated and shall be here-
7 after known as Homer avenue.

Sec. 27. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Labrosse street
4 extending east of Springwells avenue
5 be and the same is hereby designated
6 and shall be hereafter known as Mint
7 street.

Sec. 28. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Linden street, ex-
4 tending from Crawford to Waterman
5 avenues, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
7 known as Schley avenue.

Sec. 29. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit
3 heretofore known as Porter street, ex-
4 tending from Kercheval to Beard ave-
5 nues, be and the same is hereby des-
6 igned and shall be hereafter known
7 as Lisbon avenue.

Sec. 30. That the name of the street
2 and highway in the City of Detroit,
3 heretofore known as Lexington avenue,
4 extending from Crawford to Waterman
5 avenues, be and the same is hereby
6 designated and shall be hereafter
