

Sec. 18. No person shall swim or bathe in the waters of the Detroit river opposite to or adjoining that portion of the city included between the lines drawn at right angles to the river and parallel with the westerly line of Clark avenue and the easterly line of Rivard street, and between the easterly line of Field avenue continued to the river and the westerly line of Helen avenue continued to the river, respectively. Nor shall any person swim or bathe in the waters of said river at any point in the space or spaces above described, nor in any pond or other body of water situated within the limits of the city unless such person is suitably attired and while swimming or bathing conduct himself in a decent and orderly manner.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take immediate effect.
