AN ORDINANCE defining and assigning the duties necessary to the proper control and use of real property acquired or to be acquired by the City of Detroit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT:

Section 1. In all condemnation of land for purposes of the several divisions of the City Government, including the Board of Education and Public Library Commission, immediately upon confirmation of verdict roll in the Circuit Court or the Recorder's Court the Corporation Counsel shall transmit a copy of such roll to the City Controller.

Sec. 2. Within one year and (when the funds are) available to cover cost of the condemnation the City Controller shall draw his warrant on the City Treasurer in the amount of the verdict roll and present such warrant to the City Treasurer.

Sec. 3. The City Treasurer shall then proceed to pay to the several persons named in the award in the amounts mentioned and shall secure the necessary legal papers protecting the City against all liens upon the property.

Sec. 4. Upon the payment of the amount stipulated in the

 9 shall notify the Common Coun-
 10 cil of such purchase or payment,
 11 and a copy of such notification
 12 shall be sent to the Board of
 13 Assessors, whose duty it is and
 14 shall be to change the assess-
 15 ment rolls of the City of De-
 16 troit to show such property as
 17 property being exempt from
 18 taxation.

Sec. 5. At such time as the Common Council directs the Corporation Counsel to institute condemnation proceedings or the Board of Education directs the Corporation Counsel to institute condemnation proceedings, or when the City of Detroit or any of its subdivisions, including the Board of Education and the Public Library Commission purchase property through private sale, such action shall be transmitted to the City Plan Commission and the Board of Assessors. Thereupon it shall be the duty of the Board of Assessors to indicate on the assessment rolls that the City of Detroit contemplates acquiring such property, and before placing the assessment on the tax roll the Board of Assessors shall determine whether such property has been actually acquired by the City and therefore is exempt from taxation.

Sec. 6. The City Plan Commission shall keep a current index to all property owned by the City of Detroit, together with a map suitably marked, and it shall be the duty of the City Plan Commission to make an examination and investigation, survey and appraisal of each and every piece of property owned by the City of Detroit to determine whether such property is used for the purposes for which it was acquired, and whether it is used for the best purposes of the City of Detroit and to its interest, and it shall be the duty of the City Plan Commission to report annually to the Common Council any property which in its opinion is of no further use to the City of Detroit or any property which now being used might be diverted to a better use.

Sec. 7. It shall be the duty of the City Treasurer and the Board of Assessors to examine tax rolls, current and delinquent, to determine that property owned by the City of Detroit is not
