

Sec. 1. That Section 52 of Ordinance No. 254-B entitled "An Ordinance to regulate the use and operation of vehicles on the public highways within the City of Detroit, Michigan; to provide for the arrest of and penalties to be imposed upon persons violating the provisions of this ordinance, and to repeal all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 52. Any operator approaching a highway hereinafter designated as a "Stop Street" shall come to a complete stop before turning into or starting to cross such highway: Provided, That this regulation shall not apply at any intersection where traffic is being directed by a traffic officer or traffic signal, nor shall it apply to operators proceeding on Grand Boulevard, East or West, except when directed by traffic signals or officers.

The following streets are hereby designated as "Stop Streets":

- Baker Street, Sixth Street to West Grand Boulevard.
- Brush Street, north line of Jefferson Avenue to City Limits.
- Buchanan Street, Grand River Avenue to Livernois Avenue.
- Cass Avenue, north from Jefferson Avenue.
- Charlevoix Avenue.
- Congress Street, from Woodward Avenue to Meldrum Avenue.
- Chene Street, Jefferson Avenue to East Grand Boulevard.
- Dexter Boulevard, West Grand Boulevard to Fenkell Avenue.
- Fort Street West.
- Fourteenth Avenue, from South line of Baker Street.
- Grand River Avenue West.
- Gratiot Avenue.
- Grand Boulevard, East and West.
- Hamilton Avenue, Grand River Avenue to Webb Avenue.
- John R. Street, north to the Six-Mile Road.
- Jefferson Avenue, East and West.
- Kercheval Avenue, Mt. Elliott Avenue to Alter Road.
- Lafayette Boulevard and Avenue, East and West.
- Michigan Avenue.
- Mack Avenue, Gratiot Avenue to City Limits.
- Myrtle Avenue, Trumbull Avenue to West Grand Boulevard.
- Second Boulevard and Avenue, north of Jefferson Avenue.
- Six-Mile Road, East and West.
- Third Avenue, Grand River Avenue to Webb Avenue.
- Twelfth Street, from Ferry Park Avenue to Fenkell Avenue.
- Vernor Highway East and West, from East Grand Boulevard to 24th Street.

Warren Avenue, East and West. Woodward Avenue. Washington Boulevard, Michigan Avenue to Park Avenue.

**ORDINANCE No. 12-C**

AN ORDINANCE to amend Sections 6 and 7 of Chapter 140 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Detroit for the year 1926.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT:

Section 1. That Sections 6 and 7 of Chapter 140 of the Compiled Ordinances of the City of Detroit for the year 1926, be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6. It shall be unlawful for any hawker, vendor, huckster, peddler, salesman, agent or other person by himself or another, selling his wares or merchandise, or disposing of his services or granting any privileges, from any public or private place or structure unenclosed in whole or in part, to make a commotion or make unnecessarily loud noises for the purpose of attracting others, whereby the peace or good order of the neighborhood is disturbed, or persons owning or occupying property in the neighborhood are disturbed or annoyed.

Sec. 7. It shall be unlawful for any person in any vehicle to make a commotion or make unnecessarily loud noises, whereby the peace and good order of the neighborhood is disturbed, or persons owning or occupying property in the neighborhood are disturbed or annoyed.

Sec. 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its approval by the Mayor.
