AN ORDINANCE changing the names of certain streets and highways in the City of Detroit and naming a 120 foot street opened through Palmer Park in the City of Detroit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT:

Section 1. That the names of 2 the following streets and highways in the City of Detroit, be and 3 the same are hereby changed from 4 5 and shall hereafter be known as: 6 Gloucester Drive adjoining the 7 Southerly line of lots 143 to 148, 8 both inclusive of Palmer Woods
