Gentlemen—The following street name changes have been submitted to the City Plan Commission by the Bureau of Plats and House Numbers. Most of them have to do with the spelling of street names and slight changes which will give a continuous street name:

Old name, Beverly Crescent; limits, S. line of lot 1231 of San Bernardo Park sub. No. 3 and Northwestern Hwy.; new name, Oxley Avenue. Remarks: Continuation of Oxley Avenue.

Old name, Evans Avenue; limits, Greenfield and E. line of Evans Industrial Sub.; new name, Castleton Avenue. Remarks: Duplication.

Old name, Lake Shore Drive; limits, Alter Road and easterly City limits; new name, Windmill Pointe Drive. Remarks: To conform with Grosse Pointe Park.
