Gentlemen—We are in receipt of communication from the Board of Plats and House Numbers in which they suggest certain changes in names of various streets in the City of Detroit and give a uniform name to the streets.

We have gone over these proposed changes and have suggested certain modifications. These have been discussed with the Bureau, as well as with the United States Post Office. We are submitting a list of proposed name changes to Outer Drive and in order to avoid confusion we recommend that certain sections of Outer Drive and Leipzig Avenue be changed to Chandler Park Drive as shown upon the attached map.

It is necessary to change the name of Chandler Avenue between Outer Drive and Oakland Avenue. We are communicating with the owners on that street in order that a suitable name may be selected and will forward a recommendation to your Honorable Body as the necessary information has been obtained from the Chandler Park property owners.
