AN ORDINANCE changing the names of various streets and highways in the City of Detroit.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT:

Section 1. That the name of 2 Brace Avenue be and the same is 3 hereby changed to and shall here- 4 after be known as Glastonbury 5 Road, between Grand River Ave- 6 nue and Plymouth Road; and that 7 the name of Crudder Avenue be 8 and the same is hereby changed 9 to and shall hereafter be known 10 as Woodingham Drive, north of 11 Fenkell Avenue to the City Limits.

Sec. 2. All ordinances or parts 2 of ordinances in conflict herewith 3 are hereby repealed.
