To the Honorable, the Common  
Council:

Gentlemen—The following employ-  
ees of the City of Detroit were in-  
jured while in the course of their  
employment:

Clyde Hough, Edward Wright and  
Walter Bergin, employees Department  
of Street Railways; Leo Costello and  
Louis Stimmel, employees Department  
of Water Supply; Curtis Riser and  
Carmin Palmerie, employees Depart-  
ment of Public Works; Rudolph Kelm,  
employee Department of Health;  
Howard Lange, employee Department  
of Public Welfare; John Rudinia, em-  
ployee Department of Motor Trans-  
portation.

Under the terms of the Michigan  
Workmen's Compensation Law, the  
employer shall pay the injured em-  
ployees at the rate of 66 2-3 per cent  
of their average weekly wages, not to  
exceed \$18 per week, nor more than  
500 weeks from the date of the in-
