1. A liability policy in the names of the principal and the City of Detroit is also required. Limits are: Commercial General Liability \$1,000,000/2,000,000 and Excess Liability \$3,000,000/3,000,000.
2. This ordinance requires that the principal keep and maintain all sidewalks which the principal constructs during the term of this bond in good repair and fit for public travel for a period of five years from the date of completion; and also to faithfully observe the standard specifications of the City of Detroit Department of Public Works for the laying and construction of sidewalks.
3. Bailee Insurance policy in the names of the principal and the City of Detroit for the period of the license in the amount of \$1,00.
4. A liability policy in the names of the principal and the City of Detroit is also required. Limits are: Public Liability \$10/20,000 and Property Damage \$2,000.
5. A liability policy in the names of the principal and the City of Detroit is also required. Limits are: Public Liability \$100/300,000 and Property Damage \$50,000.
6. A liability policy in the names of the principal and the City of Detroit is also required. Limits are: Class A – Public Liability \$250/500,000 and Property Damage \$250/\$500,000. Class B – Public Liability \$100/300,000 and Property Damage \$100/\$300,000. Workers Compensation coverage is also required.
